
Unfortunately, that will mean that our traditional programme of summer events will not be able to take place in its usual format. However, the staff are working hard to provide alternatives, subject to any further guidance updates. Mr Martin will organise Sports Days, within bubbles. The upper KS2 team are preparing special events for our Year 6 pupils, as part of their farewell to Stonebow. The children will get to meet their new teachers on the 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> of July, when the majority of our Year 6 pupils will be involved in transition to Year 7. We have also met remotely with Friends of Stonebow, to organise some Covid safe fundraising activities. Please keep an eye on the weekly newsletter.

We are now able to undertake educational visits, with residential visits allowed from Monday. Any visits organised will be subject to specific operational guidance, as outlined in an annex to the above document.

The catch up groups have been well attended by those children invited, thank you for supporting these. Although the national assessments across the school have been cancelled this year, the children will be undertaking some internal assessments during June. These will be used to inform the children invited to the planned continuation of the catch up groups in the new academic year.
