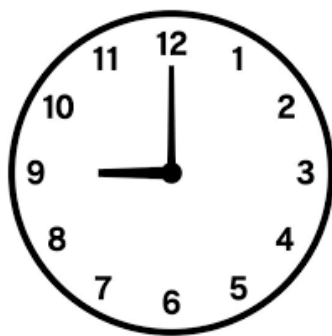

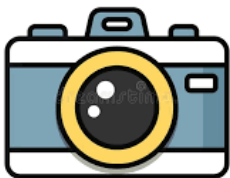

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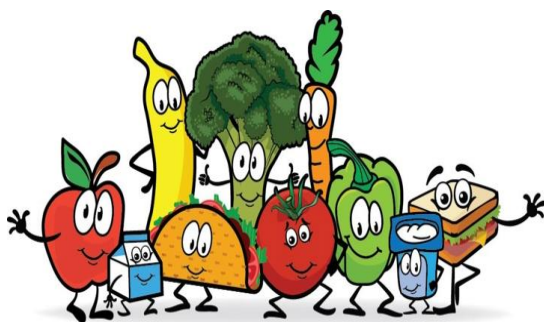
Pupils will be having individual photos taken on **Friday 29th September 2023**. Please ensure they are looking smart on the day.

Stonebow Achieve Gold!



We are delighted to announce that we, Stonebow Primary School, have achieved the School Games GOLD Mark Award for the 2022/23 academic year.

The School Games Mark is a Government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

Our sporting achievements this year include:

Developing a team of 10 Year 5/6 children to become Sports Leaders running sports and games throughout the year, two Year 3/4 Badminton Festival team (including a first place finish), Year 5/6 Girls football team who competed in their first tournament (reaching the quarter-final stage), termly football fixtures against other schools for both boys and girls, KS2 Inclusive Team who won their local competition in Boccia winning the right to represent North Charnwood at the Leicestershire & Rutland Parafest, who then went on to win the Bronze medal at the Parafest, Year 5/6 Tri-Golf team, multiple top 10 finishers at the Year 3-6 Cross Country competition (including one first place finish), Year 5 Badminton team who won a local competition and gained the rights to represent North Charnwood at the Leicestershire Primary Schools Finals.

With a total of 63 young people competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.

Mr. Marchington for attending these events and competitions with the children, members from the North Charnwood SSPAN for putting on and running these events, and finally to the parents who help transport and support their children to/at these events.
